Pattern 1001, 1002, 1003

Definitions:

- Seam Allowance (SA): The amount of space between the edge of the fabric and the stitch line.
- Notch: a marker, generally external on knits and cut into pattern in wovens, which matches with another marked point when sewing.
- Right Side Up (RSU): The side of the fabric desired for the outside or finished visible side of the garment should be face up
- Wrong Side Up (WSU): The side of the fabric desired for the inside or finished side of the garment touching the body should be face up.




Right Side
